Time Signature Mania



The time signature is found at the beginning of a piece of music. There are two numbers with one of the numbers placed above the other.

What do these numbers mean?

The number on the **top** tells us how many beats are in each measure of music.

The number on the **bottom** tells us what kind of note gets a single beat.

- 4 = Four beats in each measure.
- 4 = A quarter note receives one beat.
- 2 = Two beats in each measure.
- 4 = A quarter note receives one beat.
- 2 = Two beats in each measure.
- **4** = A quarter note receives one beat.
- 6 = Six beats in each measure.
- 8 = An eighth note receives one beat.
